

Summer Doubles Leagues

Captains' and Players' Charter

CAPTAINS WILL -

1. Issue their team's fixture list ahead of the season to their squad players.
2. Liaise with the other team captains to agree squads at the start of the season and thereafter minimise eligibility issues, especially when more than one team is in the same division.
3. Select the team and inform players a minimum of 5 days ahead of the fixture.
4. Have 1 squad member on standby for each fixture.

N.B. Captains will always have the opportunity to manage their team in a way that feels right for them and their squad.

PLAYERS WILL –

1. Tell their captain at the start of the season the fixtures they already know they are unavailable for. E.g. Pre-arranged holiday / long standing work commitment etc.
2. Tell their captain of new unavailability issues as soon as they are known.
3. Reply to captain's requests within 24 hours.
4. Accept any pairing the captain proposes.
5. Support their captain, team and club by -
 - a. Arriving at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start time for home matches.
 - b. Staying for the food at the end of all matches (Match fee £5 (£3 for juniors) for all home matches).
